



## Small Sided Football (SSF) FAQs

SSF is a great introduction to Soccer and is structured to ensure children have a fun and enjoyable experience whilst learning our great game. The AJFC Small Sided Football program is one of the most popular within the inner west. Key Information on the program includes:

- SSF is a non-competitive game format that allows players to develop their skills
- The Under 6 and Under 7s are mixed teams
  - Under 6s - children born in or after 2013 (minimum age 5 prior to commencement of season)
  - Under 7s - children born in 2012
- We encourage children to be grouped with friends and school mates and will endeavour to match any friend requests
- The season commences at the start of April and finishes start of August
- Parents are encouraged to participate as coaches or assistant coaches and are provided with all the resources required to support their team.
- Training Sessions are at Campbell Park and most usually on the following times:
  - Under 6s – 4.30pm to 5.30pm Tuesdays
  - Under 7s – 5.30pm to 6.30 pm Tuesdays
  - As all our coaches are mainly volunteer parents, the exact times and days are reliant on their availability
- All children must wear soccer boots and shin pads (they won't be allowed to play without)
- Due to the popularity of our program, the under 6 and 7s play other AJFC teams (we usually have 8-10 teams)
- Games are held at Campbell Park each Saturday morning
  - Under 6s – 9am
  - Under 7s – 10am
- Games are 4 a side to allow all the players to be involved
- No games or training are held during school holidays
- The fees for our Under 6 and Under 7s are \$210 (before active kids rebate applied)
- You are entitled to use your Active Kids Voucher for registration (please see the Active Kids Voucher information on the AJFC website)
